4. Schedule of Events:

Saturday, June 12th

- 0830-0930 Final Registration
- 0930 Skipper's Meeting
- 1100 Warning Signal for first race, subsequent races to follow
- 1830 Social at SSA, beverages available at SSA Snack Bar

Sunday, June 13th

1100 Warning Signal for racing, subsequent races to follow. No race will be started after 1500 on Sunday. The Awards presentation will be as soon as possible following final race.

- 5. **Racing Area:** The racing area will be in the Chesapeake Bay or Severn River. It will be designate by the Race Committee on each day of racing.
- 6. **Courses:** The courses will be described in the Sailing Instructions.
- Scoring: The regatta will be scored on up to five races using the low point scoring system. The plan is to have up to six races to allow for a throw out. One race is sufficient to constitute a series.
- 8. Awards: Prizes will be awarded to the Skipper and crew for the top three finishers.
- 9. Radio Communications:
 - Competitors may use VHF radios for safety.
 - VHF channels will be announced at the Skippers Meeting.
- 10. **Disclaimer of Liability**: Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See the RRS for Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for personal damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. Skippers are responsible for their crew to sign the SSA Waiver form.
