NOTICE OF RACE

1. **Rules:** This regatta will be governed by the current edition of the Racing Rules of Sailing, the requirements of the Thistle Class Association, the current Severn Sailing Association Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions, as amended, and this Notice of Race.
2. **Sailing Instructions:** Paper copies of the Sailing Instructions, including any amendments, will be available at Registration Saturday morning. The SSA Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions is available online at www.severnsailing.org under Racing. Amendments to the SSA NoR/SI will be available on the online registration page.
3. **Eligibility and Entry:**
 - This regatta is open to all R&D Thistle Class boats. Current membership in the Thistle Class Association is required for all skippers.
 - Eligible boats may enter by completing online entry form and payment (www.severnsailing.org).
4. **Fees:**

The entry fee is \$35 per boat, and includes racing, light appetizers, and homemade dessert and ice cream.
5. **Schedule:**
 - The preliminary schedule of events is as follows:

0930	Competitors' Meeting
1000	Harbor Start
1100	Warning signal for Race 1, additional races to follow as conditions permit
~1700	Appetizers & Happy Hour
<u>Sunday</u>	
1000	Harbor Start
1100	Warning Signal, additional races as conditions permit (no start after 1500)
Awards to Follow	
 - The number of races each day may vary as weather conditions permit. The total number of races for the regatta shall not exceed seven (7); one (1) completed race shall constitute a regatta.

6. Communication:

- The official notice board is located under the SSA deck in the Snack Bar area.
- Competitors may receive courtesy VHF radio transmissions from the Race Committee over VHF channel tbd concerning safety, notice of on-course-side (OCS) boats and general information to assist in the management of the event. The use of any other electronic communication devices, including cellular phones, is prohibited except in an emergency.
- Except in an emergency, a participating boat shall neither make nor receive radio communications not available to all participating boats.

7. **Venue:** The racing area will be in the Chesapeake Bay, near the mouth of the Severn River.

8. **Courses:** The courses will be as described in the Sailing Instructions.

9. **Penalty System:** RSS/US Appendix V1 and V2 shall be in effect.

10. Scoring:

- A boat's regatta score shall be the total of her race scores.
- A minimum of one completed race will constitute a regatta.

11. **Prizes:** Perpetual trophies will be awarded to the boats placing first, second, and third in the regatta.
